## Foreword

It is my great pleasure to write this Foreword for this issue of the Newsletter of the Department, since the one-off issue back in 1998. After nearly 14 years the Department has grown much bigger in size in terms of its numbers of students and staff. In particular, the size of our B.Sc in Actuarial Science programme has grown from the initial 20 intakes per year to over 60 in the last few years. The B.Sc majors in Statistics and Risk Management together have also grown substantially with over a hundred and forty new major students in each cohort. The M.Stat programme too has flourished with both full-time and part-time modes. The number of M.Stat applicants this year has exceeded 500! These figures are out of our expectations back in 1998.

Although the statistics are great, an even more important asset of the Department has been its alumni who are always very supportive and helpful to the Department. The Department is certainly very grateful to the many contributions of our alumni. One can easily find the contributions of our alumni in events like 40th Anniversary Banquet, HKU100 Gala Dinner, accreditation by the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries, conferment of SOA Centre of Actuarial Excellence, mentorship scheme and internship programme. In terms of support to the Department, we are also very grateful to Mr. Patrick Poon and Professor Saw Swee Hock for their long-time and generous support to the Department such as scholarship, prizes, as well as the endowment of Patrick S C Poon Professorship in Statistics and Actuarial Science and the Saw Swee Hock Visiting Professorship respectively.

Clearly, I cannot end without mentioning the Department's research achievement. The Department has successfully passed the last two Research Assessment Exercises (RAE) with above HKU averages. More recently, our Department was ranked by the QS World University Rankings 2011 as 26th world-wide in the subject of Statistics and is at the top of all HK institutions in this regard. The Department has also been strengthened with new blood in research and teaching. It is expected our Department will continue to flourish in its academic venture in the years to come. It is my sincere hope that the Newsletter will serve to provide a connection between the Department and the rest of our big family of alumni, friends, supporters, students, even the public. I look forward to future issues of the Newsletter and an everincreasing size of our big family.

Since 1997, the B.Sc in Actuarial Science programme has nourished more than 650 graduates, all of whom are the pride of the Department at heart.



## QS World University Rankings® by Subject

Since 2004, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) has been providing World University Rankings® and related information to help students learn more about different universities around the world.

Owing to the rank increment in various areas, namely Arts and Humanities, Natural Sciences, Engineering & IT, Social Sciences and Life Sciences, HKU went up from 23rd to 22nd in the world and was ranked the top in Asia in the QS World University Rankings® 2011/12.

Starting from 2011, QS also provides World University Rankings® by Subject for the first time. For the subject of Statistics, HKU was ranked 26th worldwide, at the top of all Hong Kong institutions in 2011. This rank is the 5th highest in all subjects amongst all Hong Kong institutions.



## SCHOLARSHIP IN **ACTUARIAL SCIENCE**

In order to encourage those students who are striving to become an actuary professional with extraordinary performance in the secondary school, Mr. Patrick S C Poon, an Advisory Board Member of our B.Sc in Actuarial Science programme and a Distinguished Science Alumnus of the Faculty of Science, University of Hong Kong has pledged a donation for establishing a maximum of 10 scholarships, equally divided between different streams of admission in the Actuarial Science programme.

The Scholarship shall be awareded to freshly admitted first year students with the most outstanding entrance record, each at HK\$50,000 or HK\$60,000, all renewable based on satisfactory performance in each year's study in the programme.

#### ABOUT THE DONOR

Mr. Patrick Poon joined the Hong Kong Civil Service as an Executive Officer after graduation (B.Sc Hons) from University of Hong Kong (HKU) in 1970.

He left the Civil Service in 1972 to join the life insurance industry as an actuarial trainee at AIA in HK. In 1975 he became the first HK born citizen to obtain the professional qualification of the Fellow of the Institute of Actuaries in UK. Later he also obtained the fellowships of actuaries in Australia, China and Taiwan. He is also an associate of the Society of Actuaries and a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries. He was Past President of the HK Actuarial Society and founding President of the Actuarial Society of Malaysia during his career with AIA Malaysia in 1976-83.

In 1987 he left AIA after a distinguished 15 years career and joined Aetna International to start up its new life insurance subsidiary in Taiwan when the market opened to foreign players. Under his leadership Aetna Taiwan became a world class life insurance and financial services organization and was known as the most successful start up life insurance company in Asia for decades.

Aetna Taiwan was acquired by ING in 2000 and Patrick joined ING as CEO of Greater China for ING Insurance and became a member of ING Group's Leadership Council (the group's top 14 managers in the world) and Chairman & President of ING Life Insurance Company of America.

In June 2006 Patrick retired from ING and joined China Pacific Life Insurance Company (CPL) as its CEO and Chairman of the Operations Committee, representing its new foreign private equity investor Carlyle. He also helped China Pacific Group to be listed in the Stock Exchanges of Shanghai (2007) and Hong Kong (2009). In October 2010, Patrick retired from the CEO position but remained as its top Adviser for a period of time.

Patrick was a board member of the International Insurance Society and a member of the Panel of Judges at the Asian Insurance Industry Annual Awards. He is currently a board member of the University of Hong Kong Foundation for Educational Development & Research. He is Treasurer, Council and Court member, Trustee of Superannuation Fund at Hong Kong Polytechnic University.


In addition to the Patrick S C Poon Scholarship in Actuarial Science and Patrick S C Poon Professorship in Statistics and Actuarial Science, Patrick has kindly pledged recurrent donations for supporting the Patrick Poon Lecture Series in Actuarial Science and also Patrick Poon Exchange Programme of Actuarial Science Teachers with Mainland China, with the aim to promote actuarial education and research collaboration at HKU.

During his 40 years' career with the life insurance industry, Patrick has won many community accolades including "The Hong Kong Ten Outstanding Youth Award" in 1985, "The K.T. Li Medal of management" in 1997, the "Outstanding Manager Award (CEO and President Category)" in 1988 and the "Order of Brilliant Star Medal" in 1999. In 2000, he won the "Best Insurance Leadership Award" at the Insurance -Belief, Hope & Love Award, and the "Personality of the Year" award at the Asia Insurance Industry Awards.

In community service, he was Charter President of the Rotary Club of HK Harbor, a member of the HK Insurance Advisory committee and a Court member of HKU. He was nominated as a Distinguished Alumni of the HKU Science Faculty in its 70th anniversary in 2009, and an Honorary University Fellow of HKU in 2011.

Patrick is now Chairman of Harvest SCP Group Company Limited.



## The 16th International Congress on Insurance: Mathematics & Economics

Organised by the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science as one of the HKU Centenary celebration events, the 16th International Congress on Insurance: Mathematics and Economics (IME) will take place from 28-30 June 2012 at the University of Hong Kong, the second time that it is to be held outside Europe and North America. It is expected that there will be over 300 scientists, academicians and professionals coming from all over the world to attend the meeting.

First held in 1997, the IME Congress is regarded as one of the only two international forums for researchers to focus on the latest advances, trends and developments in the areas of actuarial science, insurance, and financial risk modelling. It will give researchers an opportunity to present their research work and exchange research ideas.

Papers for presentation are expected to meet the aims and scope of the international journal Insurance: Mathematics and Economics. Topics of interest include but are not limited to: insurance risk models, pension mathematics, life and non-life insurance, social insurance, health insurance, reinsurance, insurance products linked to equity, applications to actuarial science of methodologies and/or results from other fields, such as probability and statistics, numerical analysis, finance, economics, operations research and risk management.

As a privileged and honourable undertaking, the IME Congress will have significant contributions to actuarial science cum financial development not only in Hong Kong but also worldwide. Therefore, the Department is very much looking forward to this great event in summer.

# Accreditation

"The Institute and Faculty of Actuaries has announced that it has approved accreditation for the BSc Actuarial Science course at Hong Kong University."

An agreement was signed between the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science and the Institute and Faculty of Actuaries (IFA), United Kingdom, to accredit the BSc(ActuarSc) programme for IFA subjects CT1-CT8, with effect from 5 September 2011.

The BSc in Actuarial Science programme, offered by the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science, is the first programme in Asia obtaining such accreditation from IFA.

According to the agreement, students who graduate with the BSc(ActuarSc) degree with the required marks in specified subjects will then be exempted by IFA for subjects CTI-CT8, or some subjects of CT1-CT3 and CT5-CT7, as they begin the journey towards qualifying as an actuary.

Curriculum Reform



In view of the growing demand from the society for talents with quantitative and statistical skills, the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science will offer new subjects in addition to its existing courses for the B.Sc (ActuarSc) and the B.Sc (Majors in Risk Management and Statistics) programmes under the new 4-year curriculum in 2012-13.

In the new curriculum, the Department of Statistics and Actuarial Science has designed a number of new courses (see table). The new courses should be able to further equip students with more sophisticated knowledge and give them a more thorough scope of study supported by a student-centred learning environment in the coming years.

Furthermore, the Department will offer a Common Core course titled "Statistics and Our Society" in 2012-13. The course should expose students to a range of statistical concepts and perspectives essential to the understanding of different scientific, social and economic issues.


